honesty / authenticity

Poly Pages only operates in ways that feel authentic and honest to the collaborators involved. We operate from a place of ruthless honesty, even when it is difficult.

collaboration over competition

Poly Pages prioritizes collaboration with others for mutual benefit, over competition. This is based in radical abundance thinking - finding that there is enough for everyone - and active deconstruction of capitalist exploitation.

de-platforming and normalising

Poly Pages is a collective that resists the platforming of individuals. We believe that normalizing non-monogamy can only happen through the removal of community figureheads, which by definition must exist in competition with others and without self-honesty. Polyamory is not a brand. Platforming is dangerous

evidence and knowledge

Poly Pages works to push the boundaries of what is known about polyamory - by consulting with academics, knowledge translation, and championing cutting-edge research. We resist the assimilation of knowledge into a single-source and do not believe in a single way to 'do polyamory'.

critical thinking

Poly Pages values critical discussion as a core skill and methodology in our work and operations. We lean towards facilitating conversations and events which are critical and inquisitive about polyamory and non-monogamy. We ask our members and our participants to join us in questioning and exploring as equals, as opposed to a student/teacher dynamic
